

Activities for 3 Year-Olds Inspired by "BFF Chicken" Book:

These activities for 3-year-olds are designed to engage young children in sensory, active, and imaginative experiences that align with the themes, characters, and messages from "BFF Chicken." The activities aim to facilitate learning through play, exploration, and social-emotional development suitable for preschool-aged children.

1. Feathered Friends Sensory Bin:

3. Friendship Feelings Board:

- **Description:** Create a "Friendship Feelings Board" with pictures of facial expressions displaying different emotions (happy, sad, excited) for children to identify and match.
- **Objective:** Introduce basic emotions, empathy, and social awareness through visual cues, helping children recognize and express feelings inspired by the story characters.

4. Chicken's Feather Craft:

- **Description:** Provide feathers, glue sticks, and paper for children to create their own feathered friends or decorations.
- **Objective:** Foster creativity, fine motor skills, and artistic expression while reinforcing the story's theme of friendship and kindness in a hands-on activity.
